

Behaviour Policy

Noah's Ark Staff will always praise positive behaviour and discourage children from making poor behaviour choices. However, when children display poor behaviour, staff will use the following processes. Staff understand the importance of consistent and fair discipline. Children will know the process so that they can make informed choices.

Stages	My Behaviour and My Choices	My Consequences
1	I have failed/refused to follow the school rules	I receive my first warning from my teacher, my name is written on the board
2	I have continued to break the school rules	I receive my second warning from my teacher, this is written on the board
3	I have continued to break the school rules	I will be removed from my class and will sit at the back of another class, I will either miss 5 minutes of break or have to stay after class for 5 minutes.
4	I have continued to disrupt the learning of myself and others	I will be removed from the classroom and will sit near the main office until break or after school. I will have a 15 minute detention and my teacher will speak to my parents.
5	I remove myself from the lesson without permission Unsafe behaviour Unkind words Unkind hands & feet	Detention in my own time My teacher will speak to my parents Persistent wrong choices will lead to a discussion with a head teacher
6	I bully another student I use discriminatory language I intentionally damage/vandalise property I jeopardise the health and safety of other students Aggressive behaviour I swear at a member of staff I have a fight with another student	Detention in my own time Fixed isolation until the end of the day My teacher will meet with my parents
7	I persistently fail to adhere to the school's rules	Permanent Exclusion
